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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-NINE.

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AN ACT relating to proceedings, on motion for New  
Trials in certain Criminal Cases.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. If a motion for new trial in any case  
2 in which a person has been convicted of any offense  
3 for which the punishment may be imprisonment in the  
4 State's Prison is denied by the justice before whom  
5 the same is heard, the respondent may appeal from  
6 said decision to the next law term for the district in  
7 which the case was tried.

SECT. 2. The provisions of this act shall apply to  
2 all pending cases.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-  
2 proved.
