STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to incorporate the West Branch Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Joseph W. Porter, Frank Gilman, Wilbur
2 F. Brann, Daniel F. Dans, Charles Woodman, Wilbur F.
3 Lovejoy, Charles L. Hathaway, Frank H. Holyoke,
4 Thomas W. Porter, H. S. Crowell, James F. Kimball.

Their associates, successors or assigns are hereby
6 incorporated into a corporation whose name and style shall
7 be the West Branch Railroad Company, and to have all
8 the rights and privileges, and to be subject to all the laws
9 of the State relating to such corporations.

SECT. 2. This company may build a railroad from some
2 point on the road of the Northern Maine Railroad Com-
3 pany in the town of Medway, and continue up the west

4 branch of the Penobscot river on the northerly side thereof,
5 running through Township A, range seven; Townships
6 number three and four, Old Indian Purchase to North
7 Twin Lake.

SECT. 3. This company shall have the right to build
2 their road upon any gauge, and use any motive power,
3 which shall be for the interest of said company.

SECT. 4. The capital stock of said company shall be
2 fixed at a sum of not over its actual cost by the directors
3 of said corporation.

SECT. 5. Said corporation shall have two years to
2 organize and file its location with the commissioners of
3 Penobscot county, and four years from the date of the
4 passage of this act to build their road, or some part thereof.
