STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of repairing the road from Kingfield to Eustis.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of five hundred dollars, to be expended in repairing the road from Kingfield to Eustis, through Jerusalem, Crocker township, and Township No. , in Somerset county; the same to be drawn by, and expended under the direction of the county commissioners of said Somerset county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This road leads to a vast fishing and hunting section, where many tourists go in summer and fall. It also leads into a large agricultural and lumbering section, and over the road there is a good deal of heavy teaming and a large amount of travel. The land on the line of the road in Jerusalem and Crocker townships, a distance of about seventeen miles, has been burned over and is nearly worthless, so that it can be assessed for but a small amount to repair this road, hence the need of an appropriation by the State to keep the road in repair.
