## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

### CLAIM OF SUSAN C. HAGAN.

Susan C. Hagan is the widow of Thomas M. Hagan, a brave soldier who served faithfully a long term of service in the late war. The claimant, who is in destitute circumstances, receives no pension from any source on account of the military service of her late husband. It is believed that this claim should be allowed as an act of simple justice.
