STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section 117 chapter 47 of Revised Statutes of 1883, relating to Bank Deposits of Married Women and Minors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one hundred seventeen of chapter forty-two seven of the Revised Statutes of eighteen hundred eighty-three is hereby amended by inserting in the fourth line of said section after the word bank and before the word "to" in said fourth line the words 'or trust company' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'SECT. 117. Money deposited by a married woman or minor, is the property of and to be paid to the order of the depositor; and is not the prop-

11 erty of the husband or parents; and such depositors
12 may maintain actions in their own names against
13 the bank or trust company to recover their deposits;
14 but this section does not apply to money fraudu-
15 lently deposited by or in the name of a married
16 women or minor, belonging to a third person. The
17 receipt of such married woman or minor for such
18 deposits and interest, or any part thereof, is a valid
19 release and discharge to the corporation.
