STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT amendatory to section one of chapter one hundred and fifteen of the Revised Statutes, affecting the salary of the gate keeper of the State Prison.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred 2 and fifteen of the Revised Statutes is hereby 3 amended by striking out the word "three" in the 4 eighth line of the twenty-first clause of said section, 5 and substituting therefor the word "five," so that 6 the entire clause shall read as follows, viz:

'Warden of the State Prison fifteen hundred dol- 8 lars, with the use, without charge, of such part of

9 the keeper's house and buildings of the State
10 appurtenant to the prison and yard, as the Gov-
11 ernor and Council may direct, and fuel for his use,
12 which shall be in full for all services, including the
13 duty of receiving and paying out money for all
14 purposes; deputy warden, one thousand dollars;
15 clerk, six hundred dollars; guards, five hundred
16 dollars each; physician, two hundred and fifty
17 dollars; chaplain, two hundred and fifty dollars;
18 gate keeper five hundred dollars; teacher, three
19 hundred dollars.'
