## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-NINE.

---

AN ACT concerning terminal facilities of railroads  
in cities.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Any railroad corporation, either  
2 before or after its time for location or construction  
3 has expired, may from time to time, within any  
4 city or town, enlarge, rearrange, change locality  
5 of, or otherwise improve its freight or passenger  
6 stations and grounds connected with either, or its  
7 terminal facilities, including reaching any wharf or  
8 wharves therein, or may provide new or additional  
9 stations, grounds and facilities as aforesaid, and  
10 may from time to time make new locations there-

11 for, including new rights of way incidental thereto,  
12 subject, nevertheless, to all provisions of law ap-  
13 purtenant to such matters, or relating to harbors;  
14 *provided*, that any new location hereby authorized  
15 shall not cross any public way in any city without  
16 the consent of the municipal officers thereof, on  
17 such terms and conditions, if any, as may be ex-  
18 pressed in such consent; and provided further, as  
19 to any lands to be taken for any purpose hereby  
20 authorized, and which may not be acquired by  
21 purchase, the railroad corporation shall proceed as  
22 authorized by Revised Statutes, chapter fifty-one  
23 (51), section sixteen (16), and acts amendatory  
24 thereof and additional thereto.
