IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-NINE.

---

AN ACT to establish a January term of the Supreme  
Judicial Court for the county of Hancock.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. In addition to the terms now pro-  
2 vided for by statutes, a term of the Supreme  
3 Judicial Court shall be held at Ellsworth, within  
4 and for the county of Hancock, on the third  
5 Tuesday of January of each year, commencing  
6 with the third Tuesday of January, A. D. 1890.

SECT. 2. Said term shall be for the transaction  
2 of civil business only, and no grand jury shall be  
3 in attendance. Unless otherwise ordered by some  
4 justice of the court, either in term time or  
5 vacation, one traverse jury only shall be in attend-

6 ance for the trial of causes, and venires for jurors  
7 shall be issued by the clerk in accordance with  
8 this section.
