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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-NINE.

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AN ACT to amend section 30 of chapter 40 of the  
Revised Statutes, relating to Inland Fisheries.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section thirty of chapter forty of  
2 the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by strik-  
3 ing out all that part of said section between the  
4 word "apply" in the first line and the word "to" in  
5 the third line, so that said section as amended shall  
6 read as follows:

'SECT. 30. This chapter does not apply to fish  
8 taken in the weirs on St. Croix river; and does not  
9 repeal the laws relating to the St. Croix, Denny,  
10 Pemnaquam, Cobscook, East Machias and Narra-  
11 quagus rivers; nor does it apply to the taking of

12 blue-back trout; except that no person shall fish for,  
13 catch, take, kill or destroy the same, with net, seine,  
14 weir or trap, under a penalty of five dollars, for  
15 the attempt and one dollar for each blue-back trout  
16 so taken, caught, killed or destroyed, to be recov-  
17 ered by complaint.
