STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 51 of the Special Laws
of the year 1887, entitled, "An Act to extend the
Charter of the Stillwater Bridge."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Said act is hereby amended by adding thereto the
following sections:

SECTION 2. Said proprietors are hereby author-
2 ized and required to sell and convey said bridge
3 and the franchise and the real estate appertaining
4 thereto, to the town of Orono, at any time during
5 said term of twenty years, for such sum as shall
6 be mutually agreed upon between said proprietors
7 and the legally authorized agent of the town for
8 that purpose appointed; and said town is hereby

9 authorized to buy said bridge, franchise and real
10 estate. And in case the parties aforesaid shall be
11 unable to agree upon the price that ought to be
12 paid by said town to said proprietors, either party
13 may apply to the Supreme Judicial Court at any
14 term thereof, held in the county of Penobscot,
15 which court, upon notice and hearing, shall have
16 authority to appoint three commisioners, who shall
17 examine said bridge and hear the parties and their
18 evidence, and determine the price that ought to be
19 paid as aforesaid. And in case said company shall
20 refuse to convey for the consideration fixed, as
21 aforesaid, then their right to take any tolls from
22 that time shall cease.

SECT. 3. Whenever said town of Orono shall
2 purchase said bridge it shall thereafter be kept and
3 maintained as a free bridge.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved by the Governor.
