STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of State Superintendent of Common Schools and his Clerk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The salary of the State Superinten-

- 2 dent of Common Schools shall be and is hereby
- 3 fixed at fifteen hundred dollars per year from
- 4 January first, A. D. 1889, which shall be exclusive
- 5 of traveling expenses as now provided by law. And
- 6 the salary of the clerk of the same shall be and
- 7 is hereby fixed at one thousand dollars from the
- 8 same date. And all acts inconsistent with this act
- 9 are hereby repealed.
- SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap2 proved.
