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RESOLVE in favor of Hollis B. Lawrence of Bangor.

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*Resolved,* That there be paid to Hollis B. Lawrence of Bangor, out of the State Treasury, a pension of six dollars per month, commencing on the first day of February, 1889.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Hollis B. Lawrence enlisted in Company L, 2nd Maine Regiment Maine Volunteers, and was duly mustered in to State service. While on his way to the seat of war, and before being actually mustered in to United States service, he met with an accident, by which he received a permanent injury, from which he has never recovered. He is now in a needy condition and must be helped by the State or cared for by public charity.
