# STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-N1NE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter four hundred and one Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five, relating to Ossipee Telegraph and Telephone Line.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter four hundred 2 and one of the Private and Special Laws of eigh-3 teen hundred and eighty-five is hereby amended 4 by inserting after the word "point" in the eleventh 5 line, the words 'or points,' and by inserting after the 6 word "Waterborough" in the twelfth line the 7 words 'or within any other town or city in the 8 counties of York and Cumberland,' so that said 9 section shall read as follows:

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<sup>SECT.</sup> 1. F. M. Higgins, Chas, H. Adams, J. M. 11 Mason, S. O. Clark, Ira S. Libby, S. E. Grant, 12 Geo. H. Swasey, E. A. Sadler, their associates, 13 successors and assigns are hereby created a body 14 politic by the name of the Ossipee Valley Tele-15 graph and Telephone Company, with all the 16 powers, rights and privileges, and subject to all 17 the duties and obligations granted and prescribed 18 by the general laws of this State relating to corpo-19 rations. Said corporation shall have the right to 20 locate, construct, maintain, and operate lines of 21 telegraph and telephone from any point in the town 22 of Limerick and terminating at such point or 23 points as they may select within the town of Water-24 borough, or within any town or city in the counties 25 of York and Cumberland, with the right to locate, 26 build, maintain and operate branch lines to any 27 point or points within the towns of Newfield, 28 Parsonsfield and Cornish.
