STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to incorporate the Weld Telephone and Telegraph Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. D. F. Holt, A. H. Jones, R. G. Devine,

- 2 G. N. Coburn, Eben Newman, R. E. Seammon, F. A.
- 3 Russell and A. D. Russell, their associates, successors
- 4 and assigns, are hereby created a body corporate by the
- 5 name of the "Weld Telephone and Telegraph Company,"
- 6 with all the rights and privileges, and subject to all the
- 7 duties provided by the general laws of this State relating
- 8 to corporations, with power by that name to sue and be
- 9 sued, to have and use a common seal, and the same to
- 10 change at pleasure; to establish any and all by-laws and
- 11 regulations for the management of their affairs not
- 12 repugnant to the laws of this State, and to do and

11 its lines.

- 13 perform any and all other legal and lawful acts incident 14 to similar corporations.
- SECT. 2. Said corporation is hereby empowered and 2 authorized to own, construct, maintain and operate from 3 some point in the town of Weld, a line or lines of tele-4 phone and telegraph through the towns of Weld and 5 through Perkins and Washington Plantation and Wilton,
- 6 to some point in Wilton Village, or to the depot in said 7 Wilton.
- SECT. 3. For the purposes of this act, the said corpo2 ration shall have, and the power is hereby granted, to
 3 erect and locate its lines along and upon the highways,
 4 streets and bridges, as now traveled by the trains
 5 carrying the United States mail, from Wilton to Weld,
 6 but in such a manner as not to incommode or endanger
 7 the customary public use thereof; and the company may
 8 cut down any trees standing within the limits of said
 9 highway, or streets, except fruit, ornamental or shade
 10 trees, when necessary for the erection, use and safety of
- SECT. 4. Said corporation is hereby authorized and 2 empowered to connect its lines with the lines of any other 3 telegraph or telephone company by contract with said 4 company, or to sell or lease its own lines at any time.
- SECT. 5. The capital stock of said corporation shall be 2 of such an amount, not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars, 3 as said corporation may from time to time deem necessary 4 for all purposes contemplated by this act, and said corposation may purchase, hold, sell and convey all real and 6 personal property necessary for said purposes.

- SECT. 6. The first meeting of said corporation shall be 2 called by any one of said corporators, by giving to each 3 of said corporators personal notice of the time and place, 4 and purpose of said meeting.
 - SECT. 7. This act shall take effect when approved.
