STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter sixty-three of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, entitled "An Act to amend section forty-three of chapter seventy of the Revised Statutes, relating to Insolvent Debtors."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter sixty-three of the Public
2 Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven is
3 hereby amended by inserting in the fifth line thereof
4 after the word "proceedings" the words 'and not
5 thereafterwards' so that said section as amended
6 shall read as follows:

'SECT. 1. When, for any cause the debtor shall
8 fail to take and subscribe the oath referred to in

9 the forty-third section of chapter seventy of the
10 Revised Statutes, he may do so at any time within
11 two years from the date of commencement of pro-
12 ceedings, and not thereafterwards, with the same
13 effect as if originally taken.'
