STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 71, section 27, Revised Statutes, as to perpetuation of notices of sales of real estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Section 27 of chapter 71 of Revised
2 Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the
3 following: 'Such an affidavit made afterwards by
4 any person, and filed and recorded with such copy
5 of advertisement, by permission of the court, upon
6 satisfactory evidence that the notice was given and
7 entered, shall be admitted as evidence of the time,
8 place and manner in which the notice was given.'
