RESOLVE in favor of East Corinth Academy.

---

*Resolved*, That the sum of three hundred dollars  
2 is hereby appropriated annually for the term of ten  
3 years, to East Corinth Academy, an institution of  
4 learning, located in the town of Corinth, in the  
5 county of Penobscot; *Provided, however*, that this  
6 appropriation is made on the express condition that  
7 the trustees of said institution shall maintain and  
8 keep in operation a school equal in rank and grade  
9 of teaching with a first-class academy; and *pro-*  
10 *vided, further*, that the governor and council, and  
11 superintendent of common schools, shall have a  
12 right at all times to visit said school when the same  
13 shall be in operation; and if in the opinion of the  
14 governor and council, said institution, at any time  
15 hereafter, shall fail to fulfil the conditions of this

16 resolve, they may, in their discretion, withhold the  
17 appropriation herein granted.
