## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE LEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to authorize Phineas Richardson, Jr., to dredge bars and navigate Kennebago Lake, in Franklin County, by steam.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Phineas Richardson, Jr., his associates and

- 2 assigns, are hereby authorized and vested with exclusive
- 3 right against all persons or corporations, of employing and
- 4 navigating every kind of boat or water craft propelled by
- 5 steam, as common carriers, on the Kennebago Lake, in
- 6 Franklin county, for the term of six years from the passage
- 7 of this act, with the right to navigate the waters of said
- 8 lake in all directions and to all points.

SECT. 2. It shall be the duty of said Richardson, his

- 2 associates and assigns, to provide and furnish adequate
- 3 and reasonable transportation and accommodations for

- 4 all ordinary travel upon said lake, and any failure on his or 5 their part to do so, after reasonable notice, shall terminate 6 the exclusive right aforesaid. Any person or persons 7 who shall invade or violate the rights hereby granted to 8 said Richardson, his associates and assigns, shall forfeit 9 and pay to the use of said Richardson, his associates and 10 assigns, not less than fifty, and not exceeding three hun-11 dred dollars, to be recovered by said Richardson, his
- SECT. 3. Said Richardson, his associates and assigns, 2 shall be allowed to charge and receive a toll of not exceed-3 ing seventy-five cents for each person transported upon or 4 across said lake on any regular trip, and a freight charge 5 of not exceeding twenty-five cents per one hundred pounds, 6 for all freight other than personal baggage, transported in 7 like manner.

12 associates and assigns, in an action of debt.

- SECT. 4. Said Richardson, his associates and assigns, 2 shall make at least one daily trip from the wharf at the 3 head of the lake, across said lake, to such point or points 4 as the principal travel may require, and return, excepting 5 Sundays, unless there be no person desiring to travel or 6 send freight either way, in which case such daily trip may 7 be omitted; such trips may at any time be omitted when 8 it shall be deemed by the person in charge of said boats, 9 by reason of wind, to be unsafe to put out.
- SECT. 5. Nothing herein contained shall be construed 2 to authorize said corporator in any manner to interfere with 3 booming, rafting or driving logs and lumber upon or over 4 said lake or its tributaries.
- SECT. 6. Said Richardson, his associates and assigns, 2 shall have the right to dredge bars and remove obstruc-

- 3 tions along the shores of said lake, when necessary for the
- 4 full enjoyment of the privileges hereby conferred.
- Sect. 7. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act is, and shall be, hereby repealed.
  - SECT. 8. This act shall take effect when approved.
