STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the Portland Railroad Company to operate its railroad by electricity.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Portland Railroad Company is
2 hereby authorized to operate its railroad, as now
3 constructed or hereafter to be extended within the
4 limits of the city of Portland and the towns of
5 Deering, Westbrook and Cape Elizabeth, by means
6 of electricity, with the consent of the municipal
7 officers of said towns (including the city of Port-
8 land), and subject to such conditions and regula-
9 tions as they may impose.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
