STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to incorporate the Thomaston Limerock
Railroad Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Atwood Levensaler, James O. Cush-
2 ing, Edward K. O'Brien, James A. Creighton,
3 Charles A. Creighton, Edward E. O'Brien, William
4 C. Burgess, Levi Seavey, Charles O. Cushing,
5 Edward O'B. Burgess, all of Thomaston, in the
6 county of Knox, and Charles A. Rollins of Bos-
7 ton, Massachusetts, and their associates, successors
8 and assigns are hereby incorporated as a corpora-
9 tion to be known as the Thomaston Limerock
10 Railroad Company.

- SECT. 2. The capital stock of said corporation
2 shall consist of five hundred shares of the par
3 value of one hundred dollars each; and said cor-
4 poration shall have power to increase said capital
5 stock further, to an extent not exceeding two
6 hundred and fifty shares more of the same par value.

SECT. 3. Said corporation shall have and enjoy
2 all the powers conferred by the general railroad
3 laws of this State, to take and hold by purchase or
4 condemnation all needed lands and other property,
5 to enable it to construct, operate and maintain a
6 railroad, from any point within said town of
7 Thomaston, from all the kilns in said town to all
8 the quarries in said town of Thomaston and the
9 quarries of the city of Rockland, for the transpor-
10 tation of lime rock and other freight; and also
11 may similarly construct and operate side-tracks to
12 and from said quarries and kilns.

SECT. 4. Said corporation shall have a presi-
2 dent, board of directors, of not less than five, a
3 clerk and a treasurer, all of whom shall be stock-
4 holders.

SECT. 5. Said corporation shall have power upon
2 vote of a majority of the directors thereof at any
3 time when a sum for the stock of said corporation,

4 not less than fifteen thousand dollars shall have•
5 been subscribed and actually paid in, to issue
6 bonds secured by the property of the corporation,
7 in such sums and at such rate of interest and to
8 run for such time as said directors may determine
9 not exceeding in all the sum of twenty-five thou-
10 sand dollars.

SECT. 6. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
