STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of State Normal Schools.

Resolved, That there be appropriated for the year
2 eighteen hundred and eighty-nine the following
3 sums for the benefit of State normal schools, to be
4 expended under the direction of the trustees
5 thereof: For Gorham State Normal School, fifteen
6 hundred dollars; for Farmington State Normal
7 School, twenty-five hundred dollars; for Castine
8 State Normal School, for enlargement of school
9 building, eight thousand dollars; for Madawaska
10 Training School, six hundred dollars.
