#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Philip Malone enlisted as a recruit in Company E, 12th Maine Regiment, Vols., at New Orleans, August 21, 1862, and is entitled to a State bounty of \$55, agreeable to General Order, Adjutant General's office, issued July 1, 1862, which he has not received up to date.
