## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section 75, chapter 4, Revised Statutes, relating to bribery and corruption at elections.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Amend section 75, chapter 4 of the Revised 2 Statutes, relating to bribery and corruption at 3 elections, by adding after the word "years," in the 4 last line—

'And at any election of State, county or muni-6 cipal officers, or of electors of president and vice 7 president of the United States, on request of two 8 or more legal voters of that voting precinct, the 9 officers presiding shall require any person desig-10 nated by said two or more legal voters to make oath

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11 or affirmation, before casting his ballot, that he has 12 neither received, offered to receive, or expects to 13 receive, or has offered to give a bribe or payment 14 of any kind for any vote to be cast at that election. 15 Any presiding officer or officers who refuse to 16 administer such oath shall forfeit not less than 17 fifty or more than one hundred dollars for each 18 offence; and any person who refuses to take such 19 oath or affirmation when so required shall not be 20 allowed to vote at that election.'
