STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making Appropriations for the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians.

Resolved, That there be paid from the State 2 treasury, to be expended under the direction of the 3 governor and council, to the agent of the Passa-4 maquoddy tribe of Indians, for the benefit of said 5 tribe, for the years eighteen hundred and eighty-6 nine and eighteen hundred and ninety, as follows: 7 For May dividends, five hundred dollars each year; 8 for distressed and contingent poor, three thousand 9 and two hundred dollars each year; for November 10 dividends, five hundred dollars each year; for 11 bounty on crops, two hundred dollars each year; 12 for ploughing, one hundred and fifty dollars each year; for salary of governor, one hundred dollars

14 each year; for salary of lieutenant governor, forty 15 dollars each year; for fuel, five hundred dollars 16 each year; for contingent purposes, one hundred 17 and fifty dollars each year; for salary of priests, 18 two hundred dollars each year; for dressing of 19 land, one hundred and fifty dollars each year; for 20 agricultural purposes, six hundred dollars each 21 year; for educational purposes, six hundred dollars 22 each year; for salary of agent, two hundred dollars 23 each year; for basket ash, one hundred dollars 24 each year; for repairing church and buildings at 25 Peter Dana's Point, five hundred dollars to be ex-26 pended in eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, and 27 two hundred and fifty dollars to be expended in 28 eighteen hundred and ninety, the same to be ex-29 pended under the direction of the agent and 30 resident priest.

All the foregoing sums to be expended under the 32 direction of the governor and council.
