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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-NINE.

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AN ACT to provide a bounty for the destruction of  
seals.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Any person who shall kill any seal  
2 within the limits of this State, except in the waters  
3 of Casco Bay, and shall under oath produce satis-  
4 factory evidence thereof, together with the tail of  
5 the seal killed, to the treasurer of the city, town or  
6 plantation, within which limits the seal was killed,  
7 shall receive from the treasurer of such municipi-  
8 pality the sum of one dollar for each and every sea 1  
9 so killed.

SECT. 2. Any city, town or plantation paying  
2 money under the provisions of this act shall be re-  
3 imbursed therefor annually from the treasury of  
4 this State.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-  
2 proved.
