STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT for the protection of fish in Kneeland
Pond.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby prohibited
2 from taking fish of any kind from Kneeland pond,
3 so called, in the town of Albany, county of Oxford,
4 for the period of four years.

SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of
2 this act shall be liable to a fine of not exceeding ten
3 dollars for each offence, and a further fine of one
4 dollar for each fish so taken, to be recovered on
5 complaint before any trial justice in Oxford county,

6 one-half to the complainant, and one-half to the
7 county of Oxford.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
