STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section eighteen, chapter one hundred forty-two, Revised Statutes, relating to appointment of Council Committee to Reform School and report of same.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section eighteen of chapter one hundred and forty-two of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word "severally" in the eighth line of said section, so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'SECT. 18. A committee of the council, consisting of three, with whom shall be associated one woman, shall be appointed by the governor annually, to

9 visit the school from time to time, and examine into
10 the treatment of its inmates, their condition and
11 progress. They shall maintain therein, a letter-
12 box, to which the inmates shall at all times have
13 free access, without the knowledge or scrutiny of
14 the officers. They shall hear complaints of ill-
15 treatment, and make such suggestions to the super-
17 intendent and trustees as they think proper and
18 make a yearly report to the governor and council
18 concerning the condition and wants of the school.
