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STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-NINE.

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AN ACT to establish the office of Private Secretary  
of the Governor of the State.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. That the governor may appoint some  
2 suitable person as his private secretary, who shall  
3 hold his office during the pleasure of the governor,  
4 and shall receive in full compensation for his ser-  
5 vices, the sum of twelve hundred dollars per annum,  
6 from January first, eighteen hundred and eighty-  
7 nine.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-  
2 proved.
