*Resolved,* That there be paid to Benjamin Smith  
2 of Appleton, a pension of six dollars per month  
3 during his life commencing on the first day of Jan-  
4 uary A. D. 1889, and this pension to be in lieu of  
5 two dollars per month as now receiving.



## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

### CASE OF BENJAMIN SMITH.

This certifies that I, Benjamin Smith, of Appleton, county of Knox and State of Maine, did on the 12th day of September 1839, receive a permanent injury while engaged in the service of the State, whereby I have been made a cripple for life, and that as I have never been granted sufficient remuneration, I hereby petition your honorable body that justice may be granted in my case.
