STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Catharine Coffran of Calais.

Resolved, That there be paid to Catharine Coffran
2 of Calais a military pension of eight dollars per
3 month from January 1st, 1889, and continued
4 during the pleasure of the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Catharine Coffran, widow of James Coffran, late of the 14th Maine Regiment, late resident of Calais, Maine, was killed by a railroad accident at Lynn, Mass., Jan. 15, 1889. He leaves a widow and five children without any property.
