5 January 1st, 1889.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Clara E. Webb, daughter of Henry Webb, private of Co. B., 26th Regiment of Maine Infantry, who died August 12, 1863. That said Clara E. Webb has been partially or wholly disabled by chronic sickness for the last twelve years and that there is no prospect of her ever regaining her health.
