### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend the charter of Maine Central Institute.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The act approved February first,

- 2 1866, entitled "An Act to incorporate the trustees of
- 3 Maine Central Institute" is hereby amended so that
- 4 the number of trustees shall not be more than twenty-
- 5 five and the number necessary to constitute a quorum
- 6 shall be seven.
  - Sect. 2. The said board of trustees shall be
  - 2 divided into five classes of not more than five per-
  - 3 sous each, the first five published in the last cata-
- 4 logue of said institute shall constitute the first class,

5 the second five the second class and so on through 6 the said list, and the term of office of the first class 7 shall expire at the time of the annual meeting of 8 said board of trustees in the year 1890, the term of 9 office of the second class in the year 1891, of the 10 third class in the year 1892, of the fourth class in 11 the year 1893 and the fifth class in the year 1894, 12 and beginning at the time of the annual meeting 13 of the said board of trustees in 1890 five persons 14 shall be annually chosen as members of said board 15 to hold office five years each, two of the said five 16 members to be chosen by the said board of trustees and three by the "Maine Free Baptist Assocition" incorporated by an act approved February, 19 1889.

Sect. 3. This act shall be in force when approved 2 by the governor and accepted by said board of 3 trustees.
