STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT prohibiting Savings Bank, Mortgage, Loan
and Trust Companies acting as Executor, Adminis-
trator or Guardian.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No savings bank, mortgage, loan,
2 trust or banking company, association or institution
3 incorporated under the laws of this State, or of any
4 other State and doing business in this State, shall
5 act or do business as executor, administrator or
6 guardian, anything in this charter to the contrary
7 notwithstanding.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 with this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.

STATE OF MAINE.

The Committee on Banks and Banking to which was referred the bill, entitled "An Act prohibiting savings banks, mortgage, loan and trust companies acting as executors, administrators or guardians," and are unable to agree and the undersigned members of the committee have had the same under consideration, and ask leave to report that the same ought not to pass.
