STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to authorize towns and cities to raise
money for the support of evening schools.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Cities and towns may raise and
2 appropriate money for the support of evening
3 schools, in addition to the sums they raise for the
4 support of the common schools. Said evening
5 schools shall admit persons of any age, shall teach
6 only the elementary branches, and shall be under
7 the direction and supervision of the local school
8 board.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
