STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT additional to the several acts establishing
the County of Piscataquis.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representative
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All officers within and for the county
2 of Piscataquis, having authority to commit any
3 prisoner or debtor to jail, shall be authorized and
4 required for the term of ten years from and after
5 March 5, A. D. 1890, if the county of Piscataquis
6 shall so long remain without a jail within its own
7 limits, to commit prisoners or debtors to the jail in
8 the county of Penobscot, in the same manner and
9 with as ample authorization as like officers in said
10 county of Penobscot are by law authorized and

11 required to do; and the keeper of the jail in said
12 county of Penobscot is hereby authorized and
13 required to receive and detain in his custody all
14 such prisoners and debtors. *Provided, however,*
15 that the county of Piscataquis shall be liable to the
16 county of Penobscot for all expenses and damages
17 which shall accrue from any and all such commit-
18 ments; and provided, also, that in case of disagree-
19 ment between the boards of county commissioners
20 of said counties, as to the compensation to be
21 received by said county of Penobscot for the use
22 of its jail as aforesaid, any judge of the supreme
23 judicial court shall, upon written application of
24 either board, after notice and hearing, fix said com-
25 pensation, and his determination shall be final and
26 conclusive in the premises.
