RESOLVE in favor of Fred P. Mahoney of Belfast.

*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the treasury  
2 of the State to Fred P. Mahoney the sum of four  
3 dollars per month as a State pension, during the  
4 pleasure of the legislature, commencing January  
5 1st, 1889.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Fred P. Mahoney was a member of Co. H, First Regiment, Maine Militia, and while acting under the immediate orders of General Charles P. Mattocks, colonel commanding the regiment, he was ruptured on the right side of the abdomen, which has caused him to suffer from hernia ever since, and hinders him from doing manual labor.
