STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend article 6, section 55 of chapter 86 of the Revised Statutes, relating to trustee process.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Article six of section fifty-five, 2 chapter eighty-six of the Revised Statutes is hereby 3 amended by striking out in the fifth and sixth lines 4 thereof the words "and this is not exempt in any 5 suit for necessaries furnished him or his family," 6 so that said article as amended shall read as follows:

'VI. By reason of any amount due from him to 8 the principal defendant, as wages for his personal 9 labor, or that of his wife or minor children, for a

10 time not exceeding one month next preceding the
11 service of the process, and not exceeding twenty
12 dollars of the amount due to him as wages for his
13 personal labor; moreover, wages of minor children
14 and of women, are not, in any case, subject to
15 trustee process on account of any debt of parent
16 or husband.'

SECT. 2. This act shall not apply to any suit
2 brought upon a contract made before the approval
3 thereof.
