STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in relation to the State Geological Collection.

Resolved, That the Superintendent of Public Buildings
2 be and hereby is authorized and directed to transfer and
3 remove the geological specimens, now stored in the base-
4 ment and other parts of the capitol building, to Colby
5 University, at Waterville, Me. ; and that the governor and
6 council be authorized to draw a warrant for the necessary
7 expenses attending such removal. Said University, as
8 far as it may be within the power of the officers of its
9 geological department so to do, shall arrange and classify
10 said specimens, label them with a card bearing the words
11 "State Geological Collection," place them on exhibition
12 during the entire college year, answer all questions in
13 reference to the same addressed to said department by the
14 people of the State and in general shall take all the care
15 and precaution which scientific institutions usually exer-
16 cise in the preservation of such specimens. Said speci-
17 mens to remain the property of the State, subject to the
18 order of the legislature.
