STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to incorporate the York Mutual Aid Association.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. That Marshall C. Decker, George
2 B. Perkins, Osea B. Starks, David Horne and
3 Frank Small, their associates, successors and
4 assigns, be and hereby are made a body politic and
5 corporate by the name of the York Mutual Aid
6 Association, for charitable and benevolent pur-
7 poses and furnishing relief and assistance by means
8 of mutual agreements and payment of funds, and
9 said corporation may sue and be sued, defend and
10 be defended, have and use a common seal, and

11 establish all by-laws and regulations which may
12 be necessary to carry out the purposes of this act,
13 and shall be vested with all the powers and privi-
14 leges and be subject to all the liabilities by law
15 incident to corporations of a similar nature.

SECT. 2. Said corporation may purchase, take
2 and hold by deed, gift, bequest, devise or other-
3 wise, personal estate for the purpose of said cor-
4 poration, to an amount not exceeding at any one
5 time five thousand dollars, and may improve, use,
6 sell and convey or otherwise dispose of same at
7 pleasure.

SECT. 3. The two first named persons in this
2 act may call the first meeting of this corporation
3 by personal notice, either written or printed, de-
4 livered or mailed to each corporator at least ten
5 days before the time of meeting.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
