STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Penobscot Tribe of
Indians.

Resolved, That five per cent of the shore rentals
2 of the Penobscot tribe of Indians, for the year
3 eighteen hundred and eighthy-nine, be taken and
4 expended for municipal purposes, and that the same
5 be expended in said year eighteen hundred and
6 eighty-nine, under the direction of the agent and
7 resident priest.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

These shore rents belong to the tribe, and usually have been divided among the tribe per capita. At request of the Indians themselves they desire to have one year's amount of these rents expended for municipal purposes instead of being divided.
