IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section 19 of chapter 18 of Revised
Statutes, relating to Town Ways.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section nineteen of chapter eighteen of the
2 Revised Statutes, as amended by section seven of chapter
3 three hundred fifty-nine of Public Laws of eighteen hun-
4 dred and eighty-five, is hereby amended by striking out
5 in the last sentence thereof, the word "recorded," and
6 substituting therefor the words "placed on file," and also
7 by striking out in said sentence the words "forty-nine,"
8 and substituting therefor the words "forty-eight," so that
9 the said sentence as amended shall read as follows :

'When the decision of the commissioners is returned and
11 placed on file, such owner or tenant or other party inter-
12 ested has the same right to appeal to the supreme judicial
13 court as is provided in sections forty-eight to fifty-one,

14 inclusive; and also to have his damages estimated, as
15 provided in section eight.'

SECT. 2. This act shall apply to pending cases.
