STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section 21, chapter 52 of the Revised Statutes of 1883, relating to Steam Navigation Companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 21 of chapter 52 of the Revised Statutes of 1883, relating to steam navigation companies is hereby amended by adding after the word "steam" in the eleventh line of said section the words 'or by collision,' so that the sentence in which said amendment is made shall read as follows:

'In case of damage by fire, or by explosion of steam, or by collision, the inspectors shall forth-

10 with investigate the cause thereof, and if found by
11 them to have been occasioned by a violation of any
12 of the aforesaid provisions, or of the order, regu-
13 lation and requirements of said inspectors, they
14 shall so certify to the governor and to the county
15 attorney in the county where the offence was com-
16 mitted with the names of the parties and witnesses,
17 and prosecution shall forthwith be instituted against
18 all parties liable.
