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RESOLVE in favor of Margaret C. McCurdy.

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*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the treasury  
2 of the State to Margaret C. McCurdy, of Bath, six  
3 dollars per month during the pleasure of the legis-  
4 lature, as a military pension.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

George A. McCurdy, husband of Margaret C. McCurdy, served as a private in Co. G, 5th Reg't, Mass. Vols., was honorably discharged upon the expiration of his term of enlistment. He died in 1883, leaving his family (wife and four children, entirely destitute. They have maintained themselves by keeping boarders and the assistance of friends. Not entitled under the law to State aid. Receives no United States pension.
