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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-NINE.

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AN ACT to amend sections two and four of the  
Waldo and Somerset Railroad Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The second section of the charter of  
2 the Waldo and Somerset Railway Company is  
3 hereby amended by adding thereto the following—  
4 “and through the towns of Cornville and Athens,”  
5 so that said section will read as follows:

‘SECT. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized  
7 and empowered to survey, locate, construct,  
8 operate, maintain, alter and keep in repair, a rail-  
9 road commencing at and connecting with the

10 Maine Central Railroad and the Belfast and  
11 Moosehead Lake Railroad, at their junction at  
12 Burnham village, in the county of Waldo, and  
13 extending thence northerly through said town of  
14 Burnham and through the towns of Clinton, in the  
15 county of Kennebec, and Pittsfield, Canaan,  
16 Cornville and Athens, in the county of Somerset,  
17 to the north line of the town of Athens.’

Section four of said charter is hereby amended by  
19 striking out ‘fifteen hundred’ in the second line  
20 and inserting instead thereof “one thousand,”  
21 and by striking out ‘five hundred thousand’ in the  
22 sixth line and inserting instead thereof “two  
23 million,” so that said section, as amended, shall  
24 read as follows:

‘SECT. 4. The capital stock of said corporation  
26 shall consist of not less than one thousand shares  
27 of one hundred dollars each, and the number of  
28 shares may be increased from time to time by the  
29 direction of the stockholder’s, with the approval of  
30 the railroad commissioners, to an amount not ex-  
31 ceeding two million dollars, in shares of one  
32 hundred dollars each. And said corporation is  
33 hereby authorized and empowered to issue its  
34 bonds to an amount not exceeding three hundred

35 thousand dollars, and secure the same by a mort-  
36 gage of its road, franchise and property, or in any  
37 other way or manner it may deem proper.'
