STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT amendatory of section seven of chapter 91 of the Revised Statutes, relating to personal property held as security for debt by agreements and notes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section seven of chapter ninety-one 2 of Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking 3 out all the words in said section after the words 4 "eighty-six" in the fifth line thereof, so that said 5 section as amended shall read as follows:

'SECT. 7. All personal property held as security 7 for debt by the agreements and notes mentioned in 8 section five of chapter one hundred and eleven is

9 subject to redemption as provided in the four pre-
10 ceding sections for personal property, mortgages
11 and to trustee process as provided in section fifty
12 of chapter eighty-six.'
