IN HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, }
February 22, 1889. }

Ordered, That the Committee on Legal Affairs
2 inquire into the expediency of the enactment of a
3 law which shall make it the duty of officers who
4 have attached personal property on mesne process,
5 and declined receipture, to take a bond in the
6 amount of the *ad damnum* of the writ, a process
7 upon which the attachment is made, certified as
8 good and sufficient by two disinterested justices
9 of the peace.
