STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT referring to release of attachment of
personal property.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Any officer who has made attach-
2 ment of personal property on any writ shall release
3 the property attached upon tender of a bond in the
4 amount of the *ad damnum* of the writ, certified as
5 good and sufficient by two disinterested justices of
6 the peace, such bond to stand in the place of the
7 attachment so released.

STATE OF MAINE.

The minority of the Committee on Legal Affairs, which was instructed by an order of the legislature to inquire into the expediency of the enactment of a law which shall make it the duty of officers who have attached personal property on mesne process, have had the same under consideration, and ask leave to report the accompanying bill "An Act relating to release of attachment of personal property," and that it ought to pass.
