STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to legalize the proceedings by which
Webster Plantation was organized.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The proceedings by which Webster
2 Plantation, in Penobscot county, were organized
3 in September, eighteen hundred and fifty-six, are
4 hereby confirmed, and the organization of said
5 plantation is hereby declared legal and valid.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
