STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An Act to facilitate the prompt administration of justice by establishing a Superior Court in the County of Aroostook, approved March 4th, 1885."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section fourteen of chapter three
2 hundred and twenty-four of the public laws of
3 eighteen hundred and eighty-five, entitled "An
4 Act to facilitate the prompt administration of jus-
5 tice by establishing a superior court in the county
6 of Aroostook," is amended by striking out the
7 words "fifteen hundred" and inserting the words
8 "eighteen hundred," and also by adding at the end

9 of said section the words 'from the State treasury,'
10 so that said section, as amended, shall read as
11 follows:

'SECT. 14. The justice of said superior court
13 may be appointed, commissioned and qualified at
14 any time after the approval of this act, and his
15 salary shall be eighteen hundred dollars per annum,
16 payable quarterly from the State treasury.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
