STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-NINE.

AN Act to restore the compensation of the County
Commissioners of the County of Somerset.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Each county commissioner of the
2 county of Somerset, from and after the first day of
3 January, eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, shall
4 receive two dollars and fifty cents a day while
5 actually employed in the service of the county,
6 including the time spent in traveling, for which he
7 shall have ten cents a mile for the distance actually
8 traveled; but he shall not have more than one
9 travel during the same hearing or session, or for

10 more than two adjournments of any regular term;
11 nor for service or travel on more than one petition
12 or case at the same time; nor anything for travel
13 or attendance at the legislature connected with the
14 annual county estimates; nor for any additional
15 trouble or expense.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
